### **LMSC V.P. JOE HOPKINS ATTEMPTS TO BRING MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER TO PHILLY**

Many of you may have heard that LMSC Director Joe Hopkins is on a quest to bring Major League Soccer to Philadelphia. Many of you probably read this on the first page of the Philadelphia Inquirer's Sports section on May 29th. Much has happened to allow this to occur, but the impetus for this began with the development of LMSC and all of the Directors' desires to ever improve and expand our Club. If Joe is successful, LMSC will play an even greater role in Philadelphia soccer.

In order to have an M.L.S. (Major League Soccer) franchise, which is the Division I of professional soccer in the United States, and have it playing in Philadelphia before the turn of the century, the first step is to build a successful Division II team here now that demonstrates strong attendance by all of the local soccer community. If successful, Philadelphia will be one of the leading candidates to win an expansion M.L.S. franchise if and when the league decides upon expansion.

Joe is working to create such a team in partnership with Richard Groff, former President of Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association, former Treasurer of the United States Soccer Federation and the preeminent leader of Philadelphia Soccer. Obviously Joe and Richard will have other partners in their group, but none will be as influential as our club.

As all of this continues to happen, with a projected opening for the Division II team in 1997, we hope you will lend your individual support to Joe and his teams, including the LMSC Derelicts (current Indoor State Champions and Delco League Division 1 co-Champions) who will continue to be coached by Joe even while all of these exciting things are occurring.

We want to wish Joe and Richard the best of luck in their upcoming efforts and negotiations. Hopefully we'll be seeing a Division II team coming to Philadelphia.

## **TWO NEW ADDITIONS TO THE LMSC BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

This year, for the first time in many years, LMSC has added two new members to their Board Of Directors. Both new members have been involved in the program for several years and have proven to be very valuable members to the program, both interested in the well being of the players.

## **U.S.S.F. COACHING COURSE GRADUATES**

Each year we allocate a significant size of our budget to making our coaches (intramural and travel) better prepared to coach. Depending on the program, we distribute various coaching manuals and coaching videos so that our coaches will be able to accomplish more with their team.

Each year, we pay the full cost to any LMSC coach who takes one of the six different coaching courses sponsored by the United States Soccer Federation. Many of our intramural coaches have completed the nine hour 'F' level course. Almost all of our head coaches in the Travel Team Program have completed the 18 hour 'E' level course, many coaches in the older age groups have completed the 36 hour 'D' course.

This spring we had another one of our Travel Team Program coaches successfully complete the very extensive 36 hour 'D' course. Congratulations to Josh Krotec, head coach of the boys Under 12 'A' team, the Hooligans on earning his 'D' level coaching license.

## **FALL REFEREE AND FIELD CREW APPLICATIONS**

Enclosed in this newsletter is an application form for the positions of referee and field crew for the 1996 Fall Intramural Program. Below is a description of each of the positions. If you are interested in working this fall in any of the positions, please fill out and mail back the application form to our Gladwyne address. Applications should be received no later than August 10th. The intramural season will begin on Saturday, September 7th and run through November 16th. Games are played each Saturday during that time period.

Referees will NOT have to be available each Saturday. They will only be asked to work on days that their personal schedule permits them. We are especially looking for girls who play in the Travel Team Program since most of their games are on Sundays.

**SENIOR SOCCER REFEREES** - Senior referees must be at least 13 years of age, have played two years of Travel Team or High School ball and have refereed at least two seasons (fall or spring) before.

Senior referees will do games which are played in the middle and older divisions and last one hour. Referees will be paid \$10 per game. Games start on the hour starting at 9:00 AM and go until 5:00 PM each Saturday for players ages 7-13. They are played at many different field sites.

**JUNIOR SOCCER REFEREES** - Junior referees must be at least 11 years of age with a minimum of two years of playing experience in the Travel Team Program. No prior referee experience is necessary.

Junior Referees will be paid \$8.00 for each session which will run approximately 75 minutes each, the players will be 5-6 years of age. Games are tentatively set for Gladwyne Playground. Sessions will run at 9:00, 10:15, 11:30, 12:45, 2:00 and 3:15 each Saturday. Referees will also be expected to help the coaches teach the basic skills and tactics of the game to the players as well as help with the skills clinic held at the start of each session.

Referees will be expected to dress in soccer attire and must provide their own whistle. The referee assignor will call all referees each Thursday to find out which referees are available for that weekend. The referee assignor this fall will again be Paul Geraghty, Jr. Rules and regulations will be forwarded to the referees.

**FIELD CREW** - Field crew members must be at least 13 years of age. Workers will be paid \$10 an hour to set up nets, line fields, remove trash and take down nets. They will need to have nets set up on Friday night or Saturday

morning by 9:00 AM at numerous sites. Field lining can be done Thursday or Friday evening or before 9:00 AM on Saturday. LMSC provides all the necessary equipment and stores it near the fields.

We will have a Head Field Crew person at each of our fields. That person will call anyone on the field crew list to help complete their work. Depending on the number of people that apply for field crew positions and the needs of the Head Field Crew person, not every applicant will be offered work.

If you are interested in any of these positions, please fill out and return the enclosed application form no later than August 10th.

## **STATE CUP HONOR ROLL**

Each year our travel teams Under 11 and up are eligible to compete in both the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups. This winter, we had three teams make it to at least the semifinals of the Indoor State Cups, capped by the Indoor State Championship of our U-11 boys, the Derelicts. This was the seventh State Championship for LMSC since 1989.

In 1990, the U-13 Gorillas won the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups in the same season. They are one of only nine teams in the state to ever accomplish that feat.

In the finals, the locals went up against Midlothian (from the Richmond area) and fell 3-0. Playing standout ball was midfielder Stefano Calvello and Morgan Frank. Corey O'Rourke excelled at defense and Zach Grauman came up from his defensive position to score the team's most exciting goal with a "cracker" from way out beyond the penalty area. Special thanks to guest player C.J. Hayward of the 'B' team who also stood out.

Under the direction of Dan Grauman and Bill Keffer, the Delinquents finished the fall season as co-champions of the U-9 First Division.

Also with our continued growth comes the need for fields. Two Lower Merion Township Commissioners have continued to support our cause. Brian Rosenthal and Alan Kessler have helped us greatly in finding new fields. They are currently working to create new field sites for us. We anticipate about 1700 participants in our Fall Intramural Program. We have over 600 players registered for the Travel Team Program. The efforts of Brian and Alan in developing more field space in the township is greatly appreciated.

Our biggest need, as always is parents of players volunteering to coach in the intramural program. We continue to put a significant portion of our budget into educating our volunteer coaches. We believe we put a higher percentage of our revenues into this than any other club in the state. Parents of intramural players are strongly encouraged to coach. We'll help you to ensure that you are prepared to ensure the happiness and skill development of your players.

We're seeing more and more former LMSC players now coaching (including two of our Directors). We now have several Travel Team coaches with collegiate playing experience. We are however, and always will be, dependent on the parental volunteer.
