FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM REGISTRATION

Please note that we only guarantee acceptance in the Fall Intramural Program if your registration is received by August 10th. Late registrations will be accepted ONLY if there are openings in the specified division. Additional registration forms may be picked up at Sneaky Pete's Discount Sneakers AFTER July 1st.

Our Fall Intramural Program will accept players born between 1984 and 1992 (plus mature 1993 births).

As an incentive to get your Fall Intramural Registration form in early, LMSC will send two tickets to the August 10th Philadelphia Freedom game to all players whose registration is received by August 1st. This will be the last Freedom regular season game before they begin the USISL playoffs.

1997 / 1998 TRAVEL TEAM ROSTERS FINALIZED

This newsletter contains a listing of our 29 boys travel teams and 15 girls travel teams. Our Under 10 boys division, under the direction of 'A' team head coach Marty Rubenstein had 110 boys tryout, a new club record. These numbers are a reflection of the great job that the coaches in that age group did last year.

One of the objectives of LMSC is to try and place as many players as possible in the Travel Team Program. Unlike other clubs that only field 'A' and possibly 'B' teams, LMSC tries to give as many players as possible a chance to play travel team soccer.

LMSC PREPARES FOR 30TH SEASON OF SOCCER

The 1997 / 1998 season will be the 30th season for Lower Merion Soccer Club. The club was originally run under four different organizations, the oldest being the Gladwyne Sports Association. In 1984, Gladwyne merged their soccer program with the Penn Valley Soccer Program and ran under the name of Gladwyne - Penn Valley. Their four directors were Ed Hochreiter, Deitmar Kohler, Mike Mandarino and Biff Sturla.

In 1989, Gladwyne - Penn Valley merged with another local soccer program, Wynnewood Soccer Club, run by current LMSC President Bruno Ceccarelli. With that merger, the program changed the name to Lower Merion Soccer Club and was run by Ceccarelli, Sturla and Joe Hopkins, who had just moved into the area. Two years later, the Narberth Soccer Program's remaining teams were absorbed by LMSC.

Since becoming LMSC in 1989, the program has grown to one of the largest in Southeast Pennsylvania. Last year, the program had 2400 different kids play. Our boys travel team is now the largest in the Delco League. This fall, we will field 29 boys travel teams and 15 girls travel teams. Since 1988, our Fall Intramural Program has grown from 380 kids to 1600 kids and a Spring Program, now numbering 435 kids was added.

Four former LMSC players are now playing professional soccer. Will Kohler is with the NY / NJ MetroStars of the MLS, Richard Wilmot is with the Reading Rage, Justin Ceccarelli is with the Worcester Wildfire and Allan Greaves is playing with the Freedom.

Numerous other former LMSC players are currently playing soccer in college, several for prominent Division 1 teams.

Some of our current young boys and girls will someday play at the high school or college levels, some might also make it to the pro level. In the meantime, we ask all coaches, parents and spectators to never forget our primary goal at LMSC:

"To provide each and every youngster with a fun filled experience in a soccer environment."

CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN LMSC AND THE FREEDOM

Since the announcement in January that Lower Merion Soccer Club 'acquired' the Philadelphia Freedom Professional Soccer Team, many LMSC people inquired about the relationship between the two programs. Many of the questions were raised because of an article in a prominent local newspaper that presented some of the facts incorrectly. This article will hopefully clarify some of the confusion that people seem to have.

From a legal standpoint, LMSC does not in fact own the Philadelphia Freedom. The Freedom are actually owned by a company called 'F.C. Speed' which is the parent organization for both entities.

The Freedom are run separately from LMSC. The Freedom and LMSC maintain separate bank accounts (in different banks). Both organizations are run as not for profit entities. Neither organization share in the other's financial concerns.

One benefit to the players in LMSC is that tickets to both the Freedom and Frenzy are offered at lower costs. For example, each player who made an LMSC Travel Team received a free ticket to a Freedom game.

Also, those people wishing to play in our Fall Intramural Program whose registration forms are received by August 1st will receive a pair of tickets to the August 10th Freedom game. We are currently planning other events that will benefit players in LMSC.

Another benefit that players in LMSC have realized is that several LMSC teams have been selected to play at halftime of the home Freedom games. Each home game, the Freedom invites local area teams (travel and intramural) to play at halftime of their games.

The youngsters that have played in these games to date have enjoyed playing in front of the crowd on the home field of a professional team and having their names announced over the loud speaker.

Several of our travel teams have also had the honor of serving as ball boys / ball girls for the home games of both the Freedom and the women's Philadelphia Frenzy team.

Another benefit to LMSC players and their families is the enclosed voucher that can be used to get tickets at 50% off the cost of any Freedom game this year. All you have to do is take the enclosed form to the ticket booth at any upcoming home game and redeem it for tickets (any quantity) at half price.

One relationship that does exist between the two organizations is that three of LMSC's Directors are also on the Board of the Freedom.

LMSC will NOT absorb any costs involved by the Freedom, nor will LMSC gain from any profits that the Freedom realize. They are two separate entities that are being run separately.

FREEDOM / FRENZY UPDATE

Under the new ownership, the Freedom have had great success. After an opening day loss to arch-rival Reading Rage, the Freedom went on a win streak that has reached six straight wins as of this writing. The Freedom and Rage are currently 1-2 in the Mid-Atlantic Division of the Pro League, part of the United Systems Of Independent Soccer Leagues (USISL).

With a 2-1 win over Reading on May 31st, the Freedom also qualified as their division's representative in the very prestigious U.S. Open Cup., a competition that has led to a National Cup Champion every year since 1913.

The Open Cup is a competition that will be competed for by eight amateur teams, eight of the 35 Pro League Teams, 8 A-League teams and all M.L.S. Teams.

The women's team, the Philadelphia Frenzy are also off to a good start and are in second place in the W-League of the USISL. Three of the Frenzy's home game are part of doubleheaders with the Freedom team. One member of the Frenzy is Missy Page who is the head coach for the LMSC Rockets, one of our Under 10 girls travel teams.

The Freedom also sponsor a 'Reserve Team' which consists of players that are currently playing at the collegiate level. These players maintain their amateur status so that they can continue playing in college. The purpose of the Reserve Team is to develop future players for the Freedom and other professional teams.

With the reserve team, LMSC is now able to offer soccer at all levels from 5 year olds through the professional level. This structure is based upon the clubs in Europe who develop youth players and have the ability to rise through the ranks all the way to the top level.

U.S.S.F. COACHING COURSE GRADUATES

Each year we allocate a significant size of our budget to making our coaches (intramural and travel) better prepared to coach. Depending on the program, we distribute various coaching manuals and coaching videos so that our coaches will be able to accomplish more with their team.

Each year, we pay the full cost to any LMSC coach who takes one of the six different coaching courses sponsored by the United States Soccer Federation. Many of our intramural coaches have completed the nine hour 'F' level course. Almost all of our head coaches in the Travel Team Program have completed the 18 hour 'E' level course, many coaches in the older age groups have completed the 36 hour 'D' course.

This winter we had another one of our Travel Team Program coaches successfully complete the very extensive 36 hour 'D' course. Congratulations to Allan Greaves, head coach of our boys Under 9 'A' team, on earning his 'D' level coaching license.

Information about future coaching courses and clinics will be mailed out to all coaches on our mailing list. LMSC will pay the full cost of all coaching courses that are completed by coaches within our program.

FALL REFEREE AND FIELD CREW APPLICATIONS

Enclosed in this newsletter is an application form for the positions of referee and field crew for the 1997 Fall Intramural Program. Below is a description of each of the positions. If you are interested in working this fall in any of the positions, please fill out and mail back the application form to our Gladwyne address. Applications should be received no later than August 10th. The intramural season will begin on Saturday, September 6th

and run through November 15th. Games are played each Saturday during that time period.

Referees will NOT have to be available each Saturday. They will only be asked to work on days that their personal schedule permits them. We are especially looking for girls who play in the Travel Team Program since most of their games are on Sundays.

SENIOR SOCCER REFEREES - Senior referees must be at least 15 years of age OR be at least 13 years of age with at least one year of reffing experience.

Senior referees will do games which are played in the middle and older divisions and last one hour. Referees will be paid \$10 per game. Games start on the hour starting at 9:00 AM and go until 5:00 PM each Saturday for players ages 7-13. They are played at many different field sites.

JUNIOR SOCCER REFEREES - Junior referees must be at least 13 years of age OR be at least 11 years of age with a minimum of two years of playing experience in the Travel Team Program. No prior referee experience is necessary.

Junior Referees will be paid \$8.00 for each session which will run approximately 75 minutes, the players will be 5-6 years of age. Games are tentatively set for Gladwyne Playground. Sessions will run at 9:00, 10:15, 11:30, 12:45, 2:00 and 3:15 each Saturday. Referees will also be expected to help the coaches teach the basic skills and tactics of the game to the players as well as help with the skills clinic held at the start of each session.

Referees will be expected to dress in soccer attire and must provide their own whistle. The referee assignor will call all referees each Thursday to find out which referees are available for that weekend. The referee assignor this fall will again be Suzie Grech. Rules and regulations will be forwarded to the referees.

FIELD CREW - Field crew members must be at least 11 years of age. Workers will be paid \$10 an hour to set up nets, line fields, remove trash and take down nets. They will need to have nets set up on Friday night or Saturday morning by 9:00 AM at numerous sites. Field lining can be done Thursday or Friday evening or before 9:00 AM on Saturday.

We will have a Head Field Crew person at each of our fields. That person will call anyone on the field crew list to help complete their work. Depending on the number of people that apply for field crew positions and the needs of the Head Field Crew person, not every applicant will be offered work.

If you are interested in any of these positions, please fill out and return the enclosed application form no later than August 10th.

ADULT WOMEN'S SOCCER

The LMSC Adult Women continue on in full force. The team has had several games with other local programs, most recently recording a 5-2 win over rival Swarthmore.

The 'Moonlight Ladies' practice on Monday evenings at Welsh Valley Middle School. The team also offers a 'beginners' practice on Thursday mornings to any player interested in joining the program but has no background in soccer.

The program is run by Karin Sturla and Nancy Worby. It's primary focus is to offer adult women a chance to play soccer, regardless of whether they have any prior experience. The team works on fundamental skills and tactics each week, as well as play in small sided games at practice. They often bring in local area school coaches to help them at practices.

Many of the players have no experience, most are mothers of Travel Team Players or Intramural Players. The team warmly welcomes new players, regardless of their soccer background. If you would like to join, please call our LMSC Hotline or send an e-Mail.

HELP WANTED, HELP WANTED

LMSC will be looking to hire one or more adults starting in August for part time administrative work. This is necessitated by the huge growth in our program. We will be looking for a responsible adult who has been with the program before in some capacity (coach, parent, etc.) to do some of the following work:

Fall Registration Assistant - This position requires a person to regularly handle the inflow of mail (including about 1600 fall registrations) and process it in a proper and timely manner.

Hotline Assistant - This position requires a person to regularly retrieve messages from our LMSC Hotline and return calls in a timely manner. During the two weeks leading up to the start of the fall season, we receive an average of over 50 calls a day.

Paperwork Assistant - This position requires a person to photocopy and distribute the necessary coaches forms, manuals, game and field schedules and well as letters to the players that go out at the beginning of the season.

These are all paid positions. Much of the work can be done from home. The positions require people to be in town between August 1st and September 10th. If you are interested in one of these positions, please send a letter with your name, soccer background and prior work or administrative experience to our Gladwyne address.
