FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM REGISTRATION

THIS NEWSLETTER CONTAINS REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR OUR FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM AS WELL AS APPLICATIONS FOR FIELD CREW AND INTRAMURAL REFFING.

Our Fall Intramural Program will be open to boys and girls not playing in the Travel Team Program who were born between 1986 and 1994. Players do NOT have to live within Lower Merion Township.

The program will start on Saturday, September 18th and run through November 20th.

Like all of our programs at LMSC, the primary goal of the Fall Intramural Program is: **"To provide each and every youngster with a fun filled experience in a soccer environment."**

Due to the limited number of fields in the township, we will be putting a cap on the number of players that we will accept into each division. Also, since we have had a shortage of coaches in some divisions over the years, we will also limit the number of players we accept into each division based on the number of adults who sign up to be head coaches.

If we do not get enough head coaches to volunteer in a division, then we will only accept enough players to fill teams that we can provide head coaches for.

For all divisions except our five year old divisions (the Atoms and Neutrons) and the Special Needs Division, there will be a late fee for registrations received after August 10th. This is necessary so that we will have enough time to make teams and schedules.

NEW LEADERSHIP AT LMSC

Lower Merion Soccer Club is a not-for-profit entity. The club is run by a three person Board Of Directors. From 1988 through 1997, LMSC was run by Chick Ceccarelli, Joe Hopkins and Biff Sturla. In 1997, Hopkins stepped down from the program after eleven years of much appreciated service. He was replaced by Marty Rubenstein, head coach for our Under 12 'A' Boys Travel Team and intramural head coach in our boys Intermediates Division and girls Microns Divisions.

This year, Chick Ceccarelli stepped down from the program after 23 years of active service. Chick was the President of LMSC from 1989 through 1998. Chick also served as head of the Girls Travel Team Program until 1997 when Nancy Worby took over that position.

All of us at LMSC would like to publicly thank Chick for his decades of leadership and service to the sport of soccer and to the community. Both Chick and Joe were major reasons for the program growing to it's current size of 2600 kids. We all want to wish Chick the best of luck in his "retirement" from LMSC. We also want to say "Thank You" to both Chick and Joe.

Replacing Chick on our Board Of Directors is Noah Gorson, our Under 10 'A' Girls Travel Team coach. Noah has been in our program for seven years. He has two daughters, both in the Travel Team Program. Noah also coached in the intramural program for many years.

With Noah joining Marty and Biff (now in his 18th year with the club), LMSC hopes to continue to offer a wide variety of programs to their very large membership.

Working with the three Board Of Directors to run the club are LMSC Directors Nancy Worby (Director of the Girls Travel Team Program), Harold Goldner (the new Director of the Boys Travel Team Program), Bryan Richardson (Treasurer), Dan Sutton and Allan Greaves.

U.S.S.F. COACHING COURSE GRADUATES

Each year we allocate a significant size of our budget to making our coaches (intramural and travel) better prepared to coach. Depending on the program, we distribute various coaching manuals and coaching videos so that our coaches will be able to accomplish more with their teams.

Each year, we pay the full cost to any LMSC coach who takes one of the six different coaching courses sponsored by the United States Soccer Federation. .

Almost all of our head coaches in the Travel Team Program have completed the 18 hour 'E' level course, many coaches in the older age groups have completed the 36 hour 'D' course.

This spring, three of our LMSC Travel Team coaches successfully completed the 36 hour 'D' level course. A special congratulations to Danielle Fagan (U-13 'A' girls team), Fred Robinson (U-12 'C' girls) and new LMSC head coach Miguel Nuila (U-9 'B' boys).

LMSC also had 16 coaches complete the 18 hour 'E' course, offered at different locations. Congratulations to the following 16 LMSC coaches:

Information about future coaching courses and clinics will be mailed out to all coaches on our mailing list. LMSC will pay the full cost of all coaching courses that are completed by coaches within our program.

FALL REFEREE AND FIELD CREW APPLICATIONS

Enclosed in this newsletter is an application form for the positions of referee and field crew for the 1999 Fall Intramural Program. A description of each of the different positions is enclosed.

If you are interested in working this fall in any of these positions, please fill out and mail back the application form to our Gladwyne address. Applications should be received no later than August 10th. The intramural season will begin on Saturday, September 18th and run through November 20th. Games are played each Saturday during that time period.

Referees will NOT have to be available each Saturday. They will only be asked to work on days that their personal schedule permits them. We are especially looking for girls who play in the Travel Team Program since most of their games are on Sundays.

LEVEL 3 REFEREES - Must be at least 17 years of age OR be at least 15 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 3 Referees will be used for games in our 9-13 year old divisions. Level 3 referees are paid \$14 a game.

LEVEL 2 REFEREES - Must be at least 15 years of age OR be at least 13 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 2 Referees will be used for games in our 7-10 year old divisions. Level 2 referees are paid \$12 a game.

Games for level 2 and level 3 referees last one hour. Games are played on Saturdays at many different sites.

LEVEL 1 REFEREES - Must be at least 13 years of age OR be at least 11 years of age with a minimum of two years of Travel Team playing experience. No prior referee experience is necessary.

Level 1 Referees will be used for games in our 5-6 year old divisions. These games pay \$10.00 per session (each session is approximately 75 minutes long). These referees will also be expected to help the coaches teach the basic skills and tactics of the game to the players as well as help with the skills clinic held at the start of each session.

ALL Referees will be expected to dress in soccer attire and must provide their own whistle. The referee assignor will call all referees each Thursday to find out which referees are available for that weekend. The referee assignor this fall will again be Suzie Grech. Rules and regulations will be forwarded to the referees.

FIELD CREW - Field crew members must be at least 13 years of age. Field Crew workers will be paid \$12 an hour to set up nets, line fields, remove trash and take down

nets. Each week, they will need to have nets set up on Friday night or Saturday morning by 9:00 AM.

We will have a Head Field Crew person at each of our fields. The Field Crew head will call people on the field crew list to help complete their work.

If you are interested in any of these positions, please return the enclosed application form no later than August 10th.

STATE CUP RESULTS

Each year our travel teams Under 11 and up are eligible to compete in both the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups.

This winter, LMSC had two teams reach the semifinals of the Indoor State Cups. Our U-12 'A' boys team, the Delinquents, got all the way to the State Championship game in their tournament. Our U-11 'A' boys team, the Lasers, got to the semifinals in their age group.

In 1990, the LMSC Under 13 Gorillas won the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups in the same season. They were only the third team in the state to ever accomplish that feat.

Since 1989, LMSC has had 25 teams make it to the semifinals of State Cups, including the seven State Champions:

SOME NOTES ON OUR TRAVEL TEAM TRYOUT PROCESS

Each spring we hold tryouts for teams in our Travel Team Program. We have listed the players who made a travel team on pages 5-8. We hold tryouts each year. Any youngster of the proper birthdate may tryout. These are open tryouts, meaning that players who made a team the year before do NOT automatically make their team again. Other players, not previously on a team, are looked at by the evaluators as well. Veteran players might move up a level or down a level, depending on how the evaluators see the players. Some players in the Travel Team Program will not make a team the following year. Players who did not make a team one year might make a team the following year. Again, tryouts are open each year.

The reason for the above explanation is that there were parents of players trying out this year who did not quite seem to understand this process. The LMSC Directors oversee the selection process in each age group but support the right of each coach to choose their own team.

This year, at the conclusion of tryouts, we had several parents complain that the process was not fair. We had a parent of a new player not previously in the Travel Team Program claim that their child was not given a fair chance against veteran players (even though that age group accepted EIGHT players not in the program the previous year). We had a parent complain that his child was on a team the year before and therefore should not be allowed to be cut this year.

We had an angry set of parents complain that their child should not be forced to drop to a lower level because it is too devastating for the child yet they saw nothing wrong before tryouts with the possibility that their child could displace some other child, on a higher level team. Another parent demanded an additional tryout for their child who he claimed the evaluators overlooked at tryouts (this request, naturally, was denied).

The bottom line is that we know the system is not perfect. It is however the best system and the fairest system that we know of. Our LMSC Directors have friends that coach in MANY other local Travel Team Programs. The tryout process is a topic that is discussed regularly. We know of no organization in the country (soccer or otherwise) that has a better system in place.

The LMSC Directors clearly state the rules, guidelines and parameters to the coaches regarding the tryouts. We monitor each age group and recognize it is the right of the coaches to pick their own team as they view the tryouts. We stand by the selections of our coaches. We also ask that parents in future seasons not be so nasty to those coaches whose decisions they do not agree with. We found the letters, phone calls and name calling of a select few dissatisfied parents to be way out of line and totally uncalled for. We hope this will cease in the future.

CONGRATS TO TODD HERMAN

We would like to take a moment to talk about one of our biggest success stories in recent years. Four years ago, Todd Herman tried out for the Under 9 travel teams and made the 'D' team. The next year, at Under 10, Todd moved up to the 'C' team. Last year, Todd again moved up, this time to the U-11 'B' team. Not ready to stop there, Todd made the U-12 'A' team this year. Congrats to Todd for all his hard work the past four seasons. We wish him the best of luck and hope he will serve as a role model for other players in the program.

Special mention also to Drew Kotler who this year moved from the U-10 'C' boys team to the U-11 'A' team, Diego Martinez-Krippner (U-11 'E' to 'C') and Ashley Aruffo and Grayce Selig who both moved from the girls U-10 'C' team to the U-11 girls 'A' team.

ADULT WOMEN'S SOCCER

Now in their fifth season, the LMSC Adult Women's Program continues to expand. The program offers both competitive soccer and instructional soccer to adult women, regardless of previous soccer experience.

The program offers an 'A' level team for advanced players and a 'B' level team for beginners. Both teams compete in the Tri-County Women's League, in different divisions.

The Tri-County Women's League offers play in the fall, spring and summer. Several players on the various teams in the league, including LMSC, also play indoor at Rocket Sports in Wayne during the winter season.

The program is run by Karin Sturla who started the program in 1994. Karin is also the President of the Tri-County Women's League which has teams entered from Downingtown, King Of Prussia, Nether Providence, Swarthmore and soon, West Chester.

The primary focus of their program is to offer adult women a chance to play soccer, regardless of whether they have any prior experience. The team works on fundamental skills and tactics each week, as well as play in small sided games at practice. The LMSC teams are coached by Tom Starke, Traci Brody and Michael Mark, all of whom have a very extensive soccer background.

Several of the 'Moonlight Ladies' are now involved in coaching in the youth program. In addition to Sturla, Nancy Worby, Devany Penne and Robyn Abi-Khattar are both playing and coaching in the program.

Many of the players had little or no prior playing experience. Many players are mothers of LMSC Travel Team Players or Intramural Players. PERSONAL SOCCER TRAINING

Many players, both travel and intramural have been signing up for personal soccer training. LMSC endorses two different programs in the area. While these two programs are NOT affiliated with LMSC, we do feel that they are run by highly qualified soccer people.

Allan Greaves offers personal, one-on-one training as well as small group training to young soccer players. Allan has been an active soccer player for over 25 years. He currently plays professionally for the Reading Rage of the United Soccer League. In 1997, Allan was a member of the Philadelphia Freedom. He is an assistant coach with the Radnor High School boys varsity, head coach for the Under 14 Delco League Select Team and head coach for our U-11 'A' boys Rovers team. Danielle Fagan, our U-13 'A' Girls Travel Team Head Coach and Rose Miller, our U-14 'A' Girls Travel Team Head Coach offer fun individual skills training to female players. Both Danielle and Rose are former players on the Villanova University Women's soccer team and other select teams. Both have a lot of experience in the competitive soccer arena and know what it takes to be the best while enjoying the game and all it has to offer.
