FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM REGISTRATION

***THIS NEWSLETTER CONTAINS
REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR OUR
FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM
AS WELL AS APPLICATIONS FOR FIELD
CREW AND INTRAMURAL REFFING.***

Our Fall Intramural Program will be open to boys and girls not playing in the Travel Team Program who were born between 1987 and 1995. Players do NOT have to live within Lower Merion Township.

The program will start on Saturday, September 9th and run through November 18th.

Like all of our programs at LMSC, the primary goal of the Fall Intramural Program is: **"To provide each and every youngster with a fun filled experience in a soccer environment."**

Due to the limited number of fields in the township, we will be putting a cap on the number of players that we will accept into each division. Also, since we have had a shortage of coaches in some divisions over the years, we will also limit the number of players we accept into each division based on the number of adults who sign up to be head coaches.

If we do not get enough head coaches to volunteer in a division, then we will only accept enough players to fill teams that we can provide head coaches for.

For all divisions except our five year old divisions (the Atoms and Neutrons) and the Special Needs Division, there will be a late fee for registrations received after August 10th. This is necessary so that we will have enough time to make teams and schedules.

UNDER 12 GIRLS PLACE SECOND IN STATE CUPS

After a lackluster fall season, the Lower Merion Warriors (U-12A) girls travel team improved to the point of just missing being state champions. A new trainer, David Jones (DJ), along with several new players (Callye Komlo, Meredith Jones, and Amanda Venezia), created an enthusiastic atmosphere for the state cup.

Not surprisingly, the team was unseeded in the state cup draw. In order to reach the state cup semi-finals, the Warriors had to beat Reading, Downingtown and Havertown. Reading had beaten them 5-0 in the Fall season. Downingtown, the #2 seed in the state cup tournament and PAGS champion, had beaten them 3-1 in the Fall season. Havertown had beaten the Warriors 4-3 in the state cup game last year. The Warriors certainly had their work cut out for them.

In the first game, LMSC defeated Reading 1-0 in a tightly fought game. Eva Williams scored the only goal. The second game was against Downingtown. In the first half LMSC had the wind and completely dominated. Meredith Jones scored late in the first half. The second half was evenly played but LMSC prevented Downingtown from scoring and won 1-0.

In the third game against Havertown, LMSC controlled most of the game and won easily 3-0 (goals scored by Eva Williams, Mariana Uribe and Meredith Jones).

By winning their bracket, Lower Merion advanced to the state semi-finals. They were the only PAGS team that still had a chance to advance to the championship game. The Warriors' opponent in the state semi-finals was Montgomery. The other state semi-final was Yardley (last year's state champion) versus Back Mountain.

Lower Merion beat Montgomery 2-0 in a well played game to advance to the state finals. Goals were scored by Meredith Jones and Eva Williams on two nice assists from Amanda Schwab. Thus far in the state cup tournament the team had not let up a goal. The defense, anchored by Christie Komlo, Christine Wallingford, Callye Komlo, Francesca Gilberti and Rosemary Peterson (in goal) had been superb.

The state championship game was against Back Mountain. Lower Merion lost the game 3-1 but the game could have gone either way. The Warriors scored first on a great goal by Eva Williams to lead 1-0 at halftime. Myra Sack just missed scoring in the first half but hit the cross bar. Back Mountain played very well in the second half and scored two early goals.

Near the end of the second half, Lower Merion hit the cross bar again and had several great chances to score

but were unable to put the ball in the net. Back Mountain scored a late goal to ice the game. Eva Williams played most of the second half with a broken arm.

Although Lower Merion had lost the game and everyone was crying, we were all very proud of the Lower Merion Warriors (soon to be known as the "Rage"). Our team had come very far and to paraphrase the Terminator "We will be back".

STATE CUP HONOR ROLL

Each year our travel teams Under 11 and up are eligible to compete in both the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups.

This winter and spring, LMSC had three teams reach the semifinals of State Cups. Our U-12 girls team, the LMSC Warriors, reached the finals of the Outdoor State Cups. During indoor State Cups, our U-16 boys (LMSC United) and our U-11 boys (LMSC Rovers), both coached by Allan Greaves, reached the semifinals.

In 1990, the LMSC Under 13 Gorillas won the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups in the same season. They were only the third team in the state to ever accomplish that feat.

Since 1989, LMSC has had 28 teams make it to the semifinals of State Cups, including the seven State Champions:

FALL REFEREE AND FIELD CREW APPLICATIONS

Enclosed in this newsletter is an application form for the positions of referee and field crew for the 2000 Fall Intramural Program. A description of each of the different positions is enclosed.

If you are interested in working this fall in any of these positions, please fill out and mail back the application form to our Gladwyne address. Applications should be received no later than August 10th. The intramural season will begin on Saturday, September 9th and run through November 18th. Games are played each Saturday during that time period.

Referees will NOT have to be available each Saturday. They will only be asked to work on days that their personal schedule permits them. We are especially looking for girls who play in the Travel Team Program since most of their games are on Sundays.

LEVEL 3 REFEREES - Must be at least 17 years of age OR be at least 15 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 3 Referees will be used for games in our 9-13 year old divisions. Level 3 referees are paid \$14 a game.

LEVEL 2 REFEREES - Must be at least 15 years of age OR be at least 13 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 2 Referees will be used for games in our 7-10 year old divisions. Level 2 referees are paid \$12 a game.

Games for level 2 and level 3 referees last one hour. Games are played on Saturdays at many different sites.

LEVEL 1 REFEREES - Must be at least 13 years of age OR be at least 11 years of age with a minimum of two years of Travel Team playing experience. No prior referee experience is necessary.

Level 1 Referees will be used for games in our 5-6 year old divisions. These games pay \$10.00 per session (each session is approximately 75 minutes long). These referees will also be expected to help the coaches teach the basic skills and tactics of the game to the players as well as help with the skills clinic held at the start of each session.

ALL Referees will be expected to dress in soccer attire and must provide their own whistle. The referee assignor will call all referees each Thursday to find out which referees are available for that weekend. The referee assignor this fall will again be Sue Obrant. Rules and regulations will be forwarded to the referees.

FIELD CREW - Field crew members must be at least 13 years of age. Field crew workers will be paid \$12 an hour to set up nets, line fields, remove trash and take down

nets. Each week, they will need to have nets set up on Friday night or Saturday morning by 9:00 AM.

We will have a Head Field Crew person at each of our fields. The Field Crew head will call people on the field crew list to help complete their work.

If you are interested in any of these positions, please return the enclosed application form by August 10th.

LMSC ALUMS IN THE MLS

This summer, two former LMSC players are playing in Major League Soccer, the top professional league in the country. Jon Conway is in his first season with the San Jose Earthquakes where he is sharing the goaltending duties. This past fall, Conway was a second team All America selection at Rutgers University. In a recent game against the Kansas City Wizards, Conway's opposing goalie was Tony Meola, starting goalkeeper for the USA 1990 World Cup Team.

Conway played goalie for many years for the LMSC Gorillas. In 1990 (when Meola was in goal for the USA), Conway was in goal when the Gorillas won both the Indoor and Outdoor Under 13 State Cups.

One of Conway's teammates on the Gorillas was Ben Olsen, now in his second season with D.C. United. Ben will hopefully be starting for the U.S.A. Olympic team in Sydney, Australia this summer. Ben has also scored two goals for the U.S.A. Men's National Team.

NEW SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

On Friday, May 26, one of LMSC's most devoted players, Rachel Savett passed away at the age of 8 ½. Rachel had just been selected for one of our youngest girls travel teams. Her father, Robert Savett, has been a coach in our program for almost a decade. She was laid to rest in her LMSC soccer shorts, she will wear them forever.

To honor Rachel's memory, the club is setting up a new scholarship program. In her memory, LMSC will award a scholarship to a former LMSC player, referee, field crew worker who will either be in college, or about to enter college.

The Rachel Savett Memorial Scholarship will be awarded annually. The LMSC Directors have not finalized details of this fund. Our Winter Newsletter will provide details of the fund, our first recipient and how people will be able to contribute to this worthy cause.

TRAVEL TEAM UPDATES

This winter and spring, many of our travel teams have had a lot of success in league play and tournaments.

ADULT WOMEN'S SOCCER

Now in their fifth season, the LMSC Adult Women's Program continues to expand. The program offers both competitive soccer and instructional soccer to adult women, regardless of previous soccer experience.

The program offers an 'A' level team for advanced players and a 'B' level team for beginners. Both teams compete in the Tri-County Women's League, in different divisions.

The Tri-County Women's League offers play in the fall, spring and summer. Several players on the various teams in the league, including LMSC, also play indoor at Rocket Sports in Wayne during the winter season.

The program is run by Karin Sturla who started the program in 1994. Karin is also the President of the Tri-County Women's League which has teams entered from Downingtown, King Of Prussia, Nether Providence, Swarthmore and soon, West Chester.

The primary focus of their program is to offer adult women a chance to play soccer, regardless of whether they have any prior experience. The team works on fundamental skills and tactics each week, as well as play in small sided games at practice. The LMSC teams are coached by Tom Starke, Traci Brody and Michael Mark, all of whom have a very extensive soccer background.

Several of the 'Moonlight Ladies' are now involved in coaching in the youth program. In addition to Sturla, Nancy Worby, Devany Penne and Robyn Abi-Khattar are both playing and coaching in the program.

Many of the players had little or no prior playing experience. Many players are mothers of LMSC Travel Team Players or Intramural Players.
